United Indians is working under strict time constraints, therefore it is crucial that we are in receipt of your submissions by March 4th. Ms. Gray-May will provide you with a receipt for the items submitted. She will also notify each artist once United Indians has completed the selection process. If submissions are not selected, items can be picked up from United Indians anytime after March 28, 2004.

Products sold in the SeaTac International Airport will be priced very competitively. Along with your contact information, please identify the wholesale price at which you can afford to sell your product and make certain it is attached to any items sent to United Indians. Please be advised that pricing must be negotiable.
